पिछले दिनों केंद्रीय स्वास्थ्य मंत्री के निर्देशन में देश के 12 मेडिकल कॉलेजों पर स्वास्थ्य विभाग, केंद्र सरकार द्वारा मारे गए थे छापे!!!

केंद्रीय स्वास्थ्य विभाग, भारत सरकार की 3 से 6 डॉक्टरों की गठित कमिटी द्वारा इस वर्ष जनवरी से लेकर अब तक देश भर के 12 मेडिकल कॉलेजों का औचक निरीक्षण किया गया। यह निरीक्षण मेडिकल कॉलेजों द्वारा उनके प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रमों, मेडिकल सुविधाओं में लगातार आ रही गिरावट को लेकर किए गए थे।

एनएमसी एक्ट 2019 के अनुसार मेडिकल कॉलेजों को न्यूनतम मानदंडों की पालना करना आवश्यक है, जिसमें इन कॉलेजों द्वारा लगातार ढिलाई/लापरवाही बरती जा रही थी। सूत्रों के अनुसार इन मेडिकल कॉलेजों में जरूरत से कम मरीज, मानदंडों से कम स्टाफ होना और अन्य मूलभूत सुविधाओं की कमी के चलते केंद्रीय स्वास्थ्य विभाग को यह कदम उठाना पड़ा। इन निरीक्षणों को इतना गोपनीय रखा गया था कि निरीक्षण दलों के सदस्यों को भी छापे के समय ही छापे वाले स्थान की जानकारी दी गयी थी। यह छापे दिनांक 24/02/2022 को उदयपुर के अनंता इंस्टीट्यूट ऑफ मेडिकल साइंस एंड रिसर्च सेंटर, अमेरिकन इंटरनेशनल इंस्टीट्यूट ऑफ मेडिकल साइंस, गीतांजलि मेडिकल कॉलेज, पैसिफिक इंस्टीट्यूट ऑफ मेडिकल साइंस और जबलपुर के सुख सागर मेडिकल कॉलेज पर

मारे गए थे। इसके अलावा 30/03/2022 को VELS मेडिकल कॉलेज, तमिलनाडू, महावीर इंस्टीट्यूट ऑफ मेडिकल साइंस, तेलंगाना, CMR इंस्टीट्यूट ऑफ मेडिकल साइंस, हैदराबाद, MNR मेडिकल कॉलेज एंड हॉस्पिटल, तेलंगाना, TRR इंस्टीट्यूट ऑफ मेडिकल साइंस, हैदराबाद और अरुंदती इंस्टीट्यूट ऑफ मेडिकल साइंस, तेलंगाना पर मारे गए थे।

एक दर्जन मेडिकल कॉलेजों पर स्वास्थ्य मंत्रालय के छापे

देश में पहली बार केंद्रीय स्वास्थ्य मंत्रालय की ओर से ऐसे एक दर्जन मेडिकल कॉलेजों पर छापे की कार्रवाई की गई है, जिनके खिलाफ शिकायतें आ रही थीं। कार्रवाई इतनी गोपनीय थी कि मंत्रालय की मेडिकल एजुकेशन विंग को भी भनक नहीं लगी। अभी तक मेडिकल कॉलेजों के खिलाफ जांच और छापे की कार्रवाई नेशनल मेडिकल कमीशन (एनएमसी) या मेडिकल काउंसिल ऑफ इंडिया (एमसीआई) करती थी।

सूत्रों का कहना है कि कोरोना में कई नए मेडिकल कॉलेजों को वीडियो कांफ्रेंसिंग के जरिये निरीक्षण करके मान्यता दे दी गई थी। इसके बाद बहुत से मेडिकल कॉलेजों की शिकायतें स्वास्थ्य मंत्रालय को मिल रही थीं। मंत्रालय स्तर पर इनकी जांच के बाद देश के केंद्रीय अस्पतालों के 3 से 6 डॉक्टरों की अलग-अलग टीमों बनाई गईं। मंत्रालय के एक वरिष्ठ अधिकारी ने बताया कि इस कार्रवाई की मॉनिटरिंग खुद

6 मेडिकल कॉलेजों को नोटिस जारी

महाराष्ट्र में धुले के एसीपीएम मेडिकल कॉलेज, राजस्थान के अनंता इंस्टीट्यूट ऑफ मेडिकल साइंस एंड रिसर्च सेंटर, पैसिफिक मेडिकल कॉलेज, गीतांजलि मेडिकल कॉलेज, अमेरिकन इंटरनेशनल इंस्टीट्यूट ऑफ मेडिकल साइंस और मद्रास में जबलपुर के सुख सागर मेडिकल कॉलेज को नोटिस जारी किया गया है।

स्वास्थ्य मंत्री मनसुख मांडविया कर रहे थे। कार्रवाई में मेडिकल कॉलेजों में जो खामियां और गड़बड़ी पाई गई, उसकी अंतिम रिपोर्ट तैयार हो रही है। इसी के आधार पर सख्त कार्रवाई के लिए एनएमसी को कहा जाएगा।

गड़बड़ियां ऐसी : छापे के दौरान कुछ मेडिकल कॉलेजों से संबद्ध अस्पतालों में मरीज कम थे। कई जगहों पर फैकल्टी सिर्फ दस्तावेजों में थे। तो लाइब्रेरी में मापदंड के मुताबिक किताबें नहीं थीं।

**इन 12 मेडिकल कॉलेजो मे से एक नाम
पेसेफिक इंस्टीट्यूट ऑफ मेडिकल साइंस
का भी!**

केंद्रीय स्वास्थ्य मंत्रालय द्वारा देशभर के जिन 12 मेडिकल कॉलेजो पर छापा मारे गए थे, उनमे 4 तो केवल उदयपुर के ही है, इनमे पेसेफिक का नाम ना हो, ऐसा संभव नहीं हो सकता। भ्रष्टाचार मे सिरमोर बन चुके पेसफिक समूह के दोनों कॉलेजो पेसेफिक मेडिकल कॉलेज एंड हॉस्पिटल, भीलों का बेदला, उदयपुर और पेसेफिक इंस्टीट्यूट ऑफ मेडिकल साइंस, उमरडा, उदयपुर मे इनके शुरू होने से ही कई अनियमितताए हर साल मिलती रही है, जो आज तक जारी है, लेकिन पैसो की खनक के चलते यह अनियमितताए हर साल नियमित हो जाती है। स्टाफ की कमी, मरीजो का

अभाव, सुविधाओ की कमी, महंगा इलाज, इलाज मे लापरवाही जैसे कई मामलो मे एमसीआई द्वारा कई बार पेसेफिक समूह के दोनों कॉलेजो मे एमबीबीएस की सीटो पर एडमिशन बंद करने के फरमान तक जारी किए जा चुके है, लेकिन हर बार यह फरमान कागजी साबित हो जाते है और ऐसे फरमान निरस्त कर दिये जाते है, जिससे इन दोनों कॉलेजो की मेनेजमेंट की सीटो को करोड़ो मे बेचने का खेल वापस शुरू हो जाता है।

गत माह सीबीआई द्वारा पेसेफिक के रजिस्ट्रार शरद कोठारी और एमसीआई, डीसीआई के कर्मचारियों के खिलाफ दर्ज की गयी एक एफआईआर ने पेसेफिक समूह द्वारा किए जा रहे फर्जीवाड़े पर मोहर लगा दी।

सीबीआई की एफआईआर के अनुसार शैक्षणिक सत्र 2016-17 मे पेसेफिक इंस्टीट्यूट ऑफ मेडिकल साइंस द्वारा 36 अतिरिक्त मेनेजमेंट सीटो और पेसेफिक मेडिकल कॉलेज एंड हॉस्पिटल के मेनेजमेंट की 60 अतिरिक्त मेनेजमेंट सीटो पर मोटा डोनेशन लेकर दाखिला दे दिया गया था। जिसकी जांच एमसीआई द्वारा लगातार की जा रही थी। इसी जांच को रफा-दफा करवाने का खेल इन सभी नामजद मुल्लिमों द्वारा किया जा रहा था। ऐसे कई मामले एमसीआई की Executive Committee की कई मीटिंगों मे उजागर होते रहे है। लेकिन वक्त के साथ ऐसे मामलो पर पर्दा डाल दिया जाता है और इन कॉलेजो को मनमानी करने की छूट दे दी जाती है। आज हम पेसेफिक समूह से जुड़े इन दोनों कॉलेजो; पेसेफिक मेडिकल कॉलेज एंड हॉस्पिटल, भीलों का बेदला, उदयपुर और पेसेफिक इंस्टीट्यूट ऑफ मेडिकल साइंस, उमरडा, उदयपुर के ऐसे ही मामलो से पर्दा उठा रहे है, जिन्हे आपसी मिलीभगत कर दबा दिया जाता रहा है। अब यह सीबीआई को देखना है कि वह इस मामले की गहनता से जांच करती है या फिर इसे ठंडे बस्ते मे डाल देती है।

सीबीआई को मिली जानकारी के आधार पर, सीबीआई द्वारा वर्ष 2020 मे संदीप कुमार; तत्कालीन एमसीआई की मॉनिटरिंग सेक्शन मे बाबू, खेजार अब्बास; डीसीआई मे बाबू, शरद कोठारी; पेसेफिक इंस्टीट्यूट ऑफ मेडिकल साइंस और पेसेफिक मेडिकल कॉलेज एंड हॉस्पिटल के रजिस्ट्रार के विरुद्ध प्रारम्भिक मामला दर्ज कर जांच शुरू की।

सीबीआई को जानकारी मिली थी कि यह तीनों व्यक्ति अन्य व्यक्तियों के साथ मिल कर, पेसेफिक इंस्टीट्यूट ऑफ मेडिकल साइंस और पेसेफिक मेडिकल कॉलेज एंड हॉस्पिटल के मेनेजमेंट कोटे मे हुई अनियमितताओं के मामलो को रफा-दफा करवाने और एमसीआई द्वारा मेडिकल कॉलेजो के किए जाने वाले निरीक्षणों की खबर और अन्य महत्वपूर्ण और संवेदनशील जानकारीयाँ लीक करने के मामले मे लिप्त है। अपनी एफआईआर मे सीबीआई द्वारा जावेद खान; तत्कालीन सहायक प्रोग्रामर एमसीआई, सचिन गुप्ता, सुशील कुमार और उसके नजदीकी रिश्तेदार बाल गोविंद को भी नामजद किया है।

A preliminary enquiry PE 1(A)2020/CBI/AC-III/New Delhi was registered on 02.01.2020 on the basis of source information against (i) Sandeep Kumar, LDC, Medical Council of India, Delhi (ii) Shri Khizar Abbas, the then LDC (Contract basis), Dental Council of India, Delhi (iii) Shri Sachin Gupta (Pvt. Person) (iv) Shri Sharad Kothari, official of Pacific Institute of Medical Sciences, Udaipur and Pacific Medical College and Hospital, Udaipur and (v) other unknown persons in connection with clearing of management quota seats of both the medical colleges from monitoring section of MCI, Delhi and leaking of sensitive information with respect to inspection dates to Shri Sharad Kothari.

2. The Medical Council of India (MCI) was a statutory body with the responsibility of establishing and maintaining high standards of medical education and recognition of medical qualifications in India. Head office of MCI was in Pocket- 14, Sector – 8, Dwarka Phase-1, New Delhi- 110077.

3. Enquiry revealed that a conspiracy was hatched between Shri Santosh Kumar, Shri Sandeep Kumar, Shri Sachin Gupta, Shri Sushil Kumar, Shri Bal Govind and Shri Sharad Kothari in connection with clearing of management quota seats, which were admitted in excess in Pacific Medical College and Hospital, Udaipur (36 seats in excess) and Pacific Institute of Medical Sciences, Udaipur (60 seats in excess) in the academic year 2016-17, from monitoring section of MCI, Delhi.

4. Enquiry revealed that Shri Santosh Kumar was in constant touch with Shri Sandeep Kumar, the then LDC, Monitoring Section (UG), posted in Medical Council of India at Delhi in connection with clearing of management quota seats of both these medical colleges. Shri Sandeep Kumar made demand for illegal gratification through Shri Santosh Kumar in connection with the above from Shri Sharad Kothari.

5. Enquiry has revealed that Shri Santosh Kumar (now deceased), LDC, posted in MCI, Delhi was in regular touch with Shri Sharad Kothari, Registrar of Pacific University, Udaipur. Shri Sharad Kothari on several occasions used to connect Shri Santosh Kumar through Shri Sachin Gupta (Private Person) over conference call. Shri Sachin Gupta had also visited Udaipur to collect illegal gratification from Shri Sharad Kothari, for Shri Santosh Kumar.

6. Enquiry has further revealed that a conspiracy was hatched between Shri Santosh Kumar, Shri Khizar Abbas, Shri Javed Khan, Shri Sushil Kumar, Shri Bal Govind and Shri Sachin Gupta for sharing sensitive information with respect to inspection dates of the said medical colleges to Shri Sharad Kothari.

7. Enquiry has further revealed that Shri Khizar Abbas, the then LDC (Contract basis), Dental Council of India, Delhi was also in regular contact with Shri Santosh Kumar LDC, MCI, Delhi for the purpose of sharing sensitive information/inspection dates in lieu of illegal gratification. Shri Khizar Abbas used to obtain the information about inspection dates of various medical colleges from Shri Javed Khan, who was Assistant Programmer in Medical Council of India, Delhi (on contract basis) and forward the same to Shri Santosh Kumar and Shri Sushil Kumar. Shri Javed Khan was having access to the MCI, Delhi database server and he used to steal the information about upcoming inspection dates of various medical colleges.

8. Enquiry has revealed that Shri Santosh Kumar received Rs 5 lakhs in cash from Shri Sharad Kothari through Shri Sushil Kumar, friend of Shri Santosh Kumar. In addition to that Shri Santosh Kumar also received Rs. 2.94 Lakhs from Shri Sharad Kothari in the bank account in Delhi on various occasions during 2016-17. Enquiry has also revealed that Shri Bal Govind, relative of Shri Sushil Kumar had also accompanied Shri Sushil Kumar to collect illegal gratification from

Shri Sharad Kothari in furtherance to said conspiracy. Enquiry has also revealed that Shri Khizar Abbas received Rs 3 lakhs from Shri Santosh Kumar which was delivered by Shri Sachin Gupta in Delhi on 20.06.2017.

9. The aforesaid acts of commission on the part of aforesaid public servants disclose that Shri Santosh Kumar (deceased), Shri Sandeep Kumar, Shri Khizar Abbas and Shri Javed Khan and other private persons were leaking sensitive information related to Pacific Medical College and Hospital, Udaipur and Pacific Institute of Medical Sciences, Udaipur in lieu of illegal gratification.

10. It is, therefore, requested that a regular case may be registered against (i) Shri Sandeep Kumar, the then LDC, Medical Council of India, Delhi (ii) Shri Khizar Abbas, the then LDC (Contract basis) Dental Council of India, Delhi (iii) Shri Javed Khan, the then Assistant Programmer (Contract basis), Medical Council of India, Delhi (iv) Shri Sachin Gupta, Pvt. Person (v) Shri Sharad Kothari, Registrar, Pacific University (vi) Shri Sushil Kumar, Private person (vii) Shri Bal Govind, Private person (viii) unknown officials of MCI, Delhi and other unknown persons under section 120-B, 379 of IPC, u/s 66B, 43(a), 43(b) r/w section 66 of Information Technology Act 2000 (as amended in 2008) and section 7 and 12 of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 (pre amended).

एमसीआई बना भ्रष्टाचार का गढ़, वर्ष 2018 में एमसीआई के इन्हीं दो कर्मचारियों को सीबीआई द्वारा किया जा चुका है ऐसे ही मामले में गिरफ्तार, उसके बावजूद कर रहे थे एमसीआई में काम

ऐसा नहीं है कि एमसीआई दूध की धुली हुई है। एमसीआई की Executive committee की नियमित हो रही मीटिंग्स के मिनिट्स से इस बात का खुलासा होता है कि कई मामलों में एमसीआई द्वारा ऐसे मेडिकल कॉलेजों के एडमिशन बंद करने के फरमान जारी होते हैं लेकिन अगली मीटिंगों में इन फरमानों को रद्द कर दिया जाता है।

गत माह सीबीआई द्वारा पेसेफिक के रजिस्ट्रार शरद कोठारी के साथ एमसीआई और डीसीआई के जिन कर्मचारियों को नामजद किया गया था, उनमें से सुशील और संतोष को 2018 में ऐसे ही प्रकरण में गिरफ्तार किया जा चुका है, लेकिन इसके बावजूद यह कर्मचारी एमसीआई में संविदाकर्मियों के तौर पर काम कर रहे थे।

एमसीआई की मॉनिटरिंग सेक्शन में तैनात दोनों कर्मचारी एमसीआई की Executive committee को करते थे गुमराह।

सीबीआई की जांच में खुलासा हुआ कि मेडिकल कॉलेजों से संबन्धित जिन बिन्दुओं पर एमसीआई की

Executive committee द्वारा ऑब्जेक्शन किया जाता था, यह दोनों कर्मचारी उन बिन्दुओं को मेडिकल कॉलेजों के साथ साँठ-गाँठ कर या तो गायब कर देते थे या फिर गलत जवाब देकर कमिटी को गुमराह करने का काम करते थे। इस काम के बदले यह संबन्धित मेडिकल कॉलेजों से मोटी रकम रिश्वत के रूप में वसूलते थे।

सीबीआई द्वारा ऐसे ही एक मामले का खुलासा करते हुए बताया गया कि वर्ष 2016 में एमसीआई के मॉनिटरिंग सेक्शन द्वारा हैदराबाद के शादन इंस्टीट्यूट ऑफ मेडिकल साइंस, टीचिंग हॉस्पिटल एंड रिसर्च सेंटर को उनकी संस्था में हुए 150 एमबीबीएस छात्रों के दाखिले को लेकर दो बिन्दुओं का नोटिस दिया। जिनमें पहला था कि संस्था द्वारा 5 सामान्य श्रेणी के छात्रों जिनके परसेंटाइल मार्क्स NEET के एक्सजाम में 50 प्रतिशत से भी कम आए थे उन्हें कैसे दाखिला दे दिया गया? दूसरा कि आखिर कैसे संस्था द्वारा सभी एडमिशन सरकारी कोटे से ना देकर मेरिट/मेनेजमेंट/एनआरआई कोटे से कर दिये गए हैं?

इन दोनों सवालों के जवाब में कॉलेज द्वारा एमसीआई की मॉनिटरिंग सेक्शन में तैनात इन दोनों कर्मचारियों से साँठ-गाँठ कर, उक्त पांचों छात्रों को ओबीसी कोटे का बता दिया गया, जबकि इनमें से एक छात्र ओबीसी का था ही नहीं। जबकि दूसरे सवाल को सिरे से ही उड़ा दिया गया, उक्त सवाल को एमसीआई की Executive committee के समक्ष रखा ही नहीं गया।

सीबीआई द्वारा इस मामले की जांच की गयी जिसमें पता चला कि इस काम के बदले इन दोनों कर्मचारियों द्वारा 4 लाख रुपए की घूस ली गयी थी।

INFORMATION

A reliable information has been received that Sh. Sandeep Kumar and Sh. Santosh Kumar, both working as Lower Division Clerks (LDC) in Medical Council of India (MCI) in conspiracy with Sh. Sushil Kumar (Private Person) are involved in corrupt and illegal activities by abusing their official positions. Sh. Sandeep Kumar and Sh. Santosh Kumar are in a habit of taking bribes from various private medical colleges in order to show favour in miscellaneous work pending with MCI. Sh. Sandeep Kumar and Sh. Santosh Kumar conspired with Sh. Sushil Kumar and demanded and obtained bribe of Rs. 4 Lakh from Shadan Institute of Medical Sciences Teaching Hospital and Research Center, Peeracheru, Himayatsagar Road, Hyderabad in the month of September, 2017 in order to show undue favour in a matter pertaining to Ist year registration of MBBS Students with MCI for the academic year 2016-17.

Information further revealed that during the year 2016-17, Sh. Sandeep Kumar, LDC, was posted in Monitoring Section of MCI and it was his duty to process the various communications received from medical colleges which were then put up before Assistant/ Section Officer/ Assistant Secretary/ Secretary of MCI for orders etc.

Information further revealed that Shadan Institute of Medical Sciences Teaching Hospital and Research Center, Peeracheru, Himayatsagar Road, Hyderabad is a recognized Medical College with intake of 150 MBBS students. The college vide its letter dated 17.10.2016, addressed to MCI, submitted a print out of online filled information of admissions along with the letter of the DME fixing the ratio of Government and Management quota. The said file was examined in Monitoring Section of MCI and they raised the following two queries on the information submitted by the college:

- (i) Five General candidates viz. Sh. Abdul Malik, Ms. Kefaya, Sh. Mohammed Mohibuddin, Sh. Mohammed Taha Hussain and Sh. Rafea Taquiuddin had less than 50 percentile marks in NEET.
- (ii) All admissions made in Merit/Management/NRI quota. No admission made in Government quota as per monitoring software entry.

Information further revealed that MCI asked the college to provide clarifications on the above queries. The letter was signed by Smt. S. Savitha, Assistant Secretary, MCI and also bear the initial of Sh. Sandeep Kumar, LDC. In response, the college vide letter dated 22.11.2016 informed MCI that the said five candidates were OBC candidates and not General candidates. In support of their claim, the college authorities submitted NEET (UG-2016) result sheet of the said five candidate's alongwith their OBC Caste Certificates.

Information further revealed that the clarification was placed before Monitoring Sub-Committee of MCI on 15.12.2016 and the minutes of the Monitoring Sub-Committee were placed before the Executive Committee on 13.01.2017 wherein the

Committee approved the recommendation of the Monitoring Sub-Committee with regard to caste certificates of the said 5 candidates. However, the matter of all admissions being made in Management/ NRI quota was referred back to the Monitoring Sub-Committee as the reply of the college was not received on this point. However, MCI officials did not take any action on the said matter but instead the matter was put up before Monitoring Sub-Committee on 20.02.2017 and subsequently before the Executive Committee on 11.04.2017.


Information further revealed that the Executive Committee approved the minutes of Monitoring Sub-Committee, but decided to discharge the said five candidates and the same was accordingly communicated to the college. In response, the college vide its letter dated 27.04.2017 submitted that the college had wrongly entered the category in respect of the said five candidates as General; however, all of them belonged to OBC category. In support of this, the college also submitted certified copy of NEET 2016 result and OBC certificates in respect of the said five candidates. Subsequently, this clarification was placed before the Monitoring Sub-Committee on 29.05.2017 wherein the Committee decided that the caste certificates of the said five candidates were verified as belonging to OBC category on 15/12/2016. This decision of the Monitoring Sub-Committee was placed before and approved by the Executive Committee on 13.07.2017. Thereafter, vide letter dated 19.07.2017 the decision for withdrawal of discharge notice dated 26.04.2017 was taken back by MCI and accordingly intimated to the college.

Information further revealed that out of the aforesaid five candidates, the OBC certificate of one candidate namely Sh. Abdul Malik was issued by Government of Telangana, Revenue Department on 22.11.2016. This is highly suspicious as the clarification from the college was sought by MCI on 16.11.2016 and the college vide letter dated 22.11.2016 informed MCI that the said five candidates were OBC candidates and not General candidates. This shows that the matter was not properly scrutinized by MCI officials including Sh. Sandeep Kumar, LDC. The MCI officials did not verify the above said facts from the office of Medical Education Department, Government of Andhra Pradesh but instead considered the representation as submitted by the college itself.

Information further revealed that in lieu of the favour shown to the college by way of regularizing the course of action regarding admission of five MBBS candidates, Sh. Sandeep Kumar, LDC of MCI, Sh. Santosh Kumar, LDC of MCI and Sh. Sushil Kumar, Private Person visited Hyderabad between 08.09.2017 to 10.09.2017, and collected an amount of Rs. 4 Lakh from an employee of Shadan Institute of Medical Sciences.

The aforesaid facts and circumstances prima facie disclose commission of cognizable offences punishable u/s 120-B of IPC and Section 7, 12 and 13(2) r/w 13(1)(d) of PC Act by Sh. Sandeep Kumar, LDC of MCI, Sh. Santosh Kumar, LDC of MCI, Sh. Sushil Kumar, Private Person, Shadan Institute of Medical Sciences and other unknown persons.

A regular case is, therefore, registered against Sh. Sandeep Kumar, LDC, MCI, Sh. Santosh Kumar, LDC, MCI, Sh. Sushil Kumar, Private Person, Shadan Institute of Medical Sciences and other unknown persons punishable u/s 120-B of IPC and Section 7, 12 and 13(2) r/w 13(1)(d) of PC Act and is entrusted to Sh. Sushil Kumar, Inspector, CBI/AC-III, New Delhi for investigation.

1. Many Junior Residents were not regular as evident from their salary statements.
2. While making round at 10 a.m., it was observed by assessor that there was no woman in the Labour room & no case of Caesarean was listed for the day.
3. Histopathology & Cytopathology workload is inadequate as detailed in the report.
4. Anatomy department: Specimens are not labelled.
5. Pathology department: There are 142 specimens which are not labelled.
6. Microbiology department: 7 Service laboratories are not available. Central Laboratory is used which is not a substitute for 7 different service laboratories.
7. Pharmacology department: Clinical Physiology laboratory is also used as Experimental Pharmacology laboratory.
8. Forensic Medicine department: There are NIL Medico-legal specimens in the museum.

9. Laboratories are shared between departments; however in the assessment report, there is no mention of 2 small laboratories of 90 sq.m. required as per Regulations.
10. RHTC: It is not as per MSR norms. It is running in rented house of which the agreement is done on Non judicial stamp paper purchased just 1 week before assessment on 27/12/2016. Specialists' visits are not organized. Immunization is not carried out at RHTC but it is done by Govt. staff at sub-center. Cold chain is not available.
11. UHC is running in a building owned by the Chairman but yet not handed over to the Institute. Specialists' visits are not organized. Paramedical staff is inadequate. Cold chain equipment is not available.
12. There are no fire safety measures in hostels.
13. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

In view of above, the Executive Committee of the Council decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to renew the permission for admission of 3rd batch of 150 MBBS students at Pacific Institute of Medical Sciences, Umarda, Udaipur under Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Jaipur u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-2018.

4. Shortage of Residents is 83.00 % as detailed in the report.
5. Total number of CMOs are inadequate for round the clock duty.
6. Bed Occupancy is 61.2 % at 10 a.m. on day of assessment.
7. OPD attendance data supplied by the Institute are overinflated. Patients names are entered in computer system without availability of patient, particularly in ENT, Ophthalmology. All new & old patients are counted twice in Ophthalmology.
8. There was NIL Normal Delivery & only 1 Caesarean Section on day of assessment.
9. Wards: Psychiatry ward was closed. Pantry & Store rooms are not furnished in all the wards. There is no Demonstration room in 5th floor General medicine ward. There is no Unitwise bed distribution. General Surgery ward Demonstration room was shown as that for Paediatrics; it was locked & key was not available.
10. ICUs: Registers of ICCU & MICU are not maintained differently. SICU is shown with Neurosurgery ICU. Details of patients admitted in ICCU & ICUs on day of assessment are not provided.
11. Labour room: Eclampsia room is not available.
12. Medical Education Unit: No orientation programme is conducted. No member of MEU has undergone advanced training course.
13. Central photography Section: Although it is claimed that the staff is available, the list of available staff is not provided.
14. Students' Hostels: Recreation rooms are not furnished. Indoor games are not provided.
15. Residents' Hostel: Female Residents' Hostel is closed without use.
16. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report

In view of above, the Executive Committee of the Council decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to renew the permission for admission of 4th batch of 150 MBBS students at Pacific Institute of Medical Sciences, Umarda, Udaipur, Rajasthan under Sai Tirupati University Udaipur u/s 10A of the IMC Act,

Subject: Renewal of Permission for 4th batch of 150 MBBS seats at Pacific Institute of Medical Sciences, Udaipur, Rajasthan (PIMS) for the academic year 2018-19- Disapproval -reg.

Whereas the Medical Council of India vide letter dated 31.10.2017 recommended to the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare not to renew the permission for admission of 150 MBBS seats in the year 2018-19 (4th batch) at Pacific Institute of Medical Sciences, Udaipur, Rajasthan and also applied Clause 8(3)(1)(b) of Establishment of Medical College Regulations, 1999 informing as under:-

The Executive Committee of the Council considered the assessment report 21st and 22nd August, 2017) and noted the following:-

1. Deficiency of faculty is 43.50 % as detailed in the report.
2. Dr. K.K. Sharma, Dean possesses total teaching experience as Professor + Associate Professor of 9 years 7 months against requirement of 10 years; hence not qualified to hold the post.
3. Non-medical faculty in Biochemistry is 80.00 % against maximum permissible limit of 50 %.
4. Shortage of Residents is 83.00 % as detailed in the report.
5. Total number of CMOs are inadequate for round the clock duty.
6. Bed Occupancy is 61.2 % at 10 a.m. on day of assessment.
7. OPD attendance data supplied by the Institute are overinflated. Patients names are entered in computer system without availability of patient, particularly in ENT, Ophthalmology. All new & old patients are counted twice in Ophthalmology.
8. There was NIL Normal Delivery & only 1 Caesarean Section on day of assessment.
9. Wards: Psychiatry ward was closed. Pantry & Store rooms are not furnished in all the wards. There is no Demonstration room in 5th floor General medicine ward. There is no Unit-wise bed distribution. General Surgery ward Demonstration room was shown as that for Paediatrics; it was locked & key was not available.
10. ICUs: Registers of ICCU & MICU are not maintained differently. SICU is shown with Neurosurgery ICU. Details of patients admitted in ICCU & ICUs on day of assessment are not provided.
11. Labour room: Eclampsia room is not available.
12. Medical Education Unit: No orientation programme is conducted. No member of MEU has undergone advanced training course.
13. Central photography Section: Although it is claimed that the staff is available, the list of available staff is not provided.
14. Students' Hostels: Recreation rooms are not furnished. Indoor games are not provided.
15. Residents' Hostel: Female Residents' Hostel is closed without use.

In view of above, the Executive Committee of the Council decided to recommend to the Central govt. not to renew the permission for admission of 4th batch of 150 MBBS students at Pacific Institute of Medical Sciences, Umarda, Udaipur, Rajasthan under Sai Tirupati University Udaipur u/s 10 A of IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2018-19 and further decided to apply clause 8(3)(1)(b) of the Establishment of Medical College Regulation (Amendment), 2010 (Part II), dated 16th April, 2010 and amended on 18th March, 2016 provides as under:-

"8(3)(1).....

(b) Colleges in the stage from III renewal (i.e. Admission of fourth batch) till recognition of the institute for award of MBBS degree

If it is observed during any inspection of the institute that the deficiency of teaching faculty and/or Residents is more than 20% and/or bed occupancy is <65 %, compliance of rectification of deficiencies from such an institute will not be considered for renewal of permission in that Academic year"

2. Whereas, as per Section 10A (4) of Indian Medical Council (IMC) Act, 1956, the Institute was granted hearing on 29.11.2017 in the Ministry to present the case of the Institute vis-à-vis disapproval letter of the MCI;
3. Whereas representative(s) of the Institute appeared before the Hearing Committee constituted for the purpose in the Ministry and made submissions in the light of recommendation of MCI;
4. Whereas the Hearing Committee, after considering the submissions/ compliance furnished by the Institute, observed as under:-

"High order deficiency of faculty (43.5 %) and residents (83 %) has been pointed out. It cannot be satisfactorily said that the twin deficiencies have been meted even as on date. The college could also not provide any real time information in respect of admission details of patients.

In view of the above, the recommendation of MCI for disapproval may be accepted".

A copy of the hearing committee report containing their observation is enclosed.

5. Whereas the Institute has filed a D.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 3800/2018 in Rajasthan High Court, Jodhpur and the Hon'ble Court vide order dated 21.03.2018 has directed to conduct compliance inspection for renewal of permission for 4th batch at Pacific Institute of Medical Sciences, Udaipur, Rajasthan (PIMS) for the academic year 2018-19;

Now therefore, The Central Government, after considering the recommendation dated 31.10.2017 of MCI, recommendation of the Hearing Committee and reply dated 11.05.2018 of MCI, has decided not to renew the permission for admission of 4th batch of 150 MBBS students at Pacific Institute of Medical Sciences, Udaipur, Rajasthan (PIMS) for the academic year 2018-19. The Institute is accordingly directed not to admit any student in MBBS course for the academic session 2018-19.
